Meeting Outcomes

The Independent Liquor & Gaming Authority (the Authority) held a meeting on 18 March 2026 to consider applications and other matters under the *Gaming and Liquor Administration Act 2007*, *Liquor Act 2007*, *Gaming Machines Act 2001*, and the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*. The next meeting is scheduled for 22 April 2026.

The Authority considered the following matters, and the status of each matter is listed below.

Definitions:

Approved – The matter has been approved. The approval may be subject to conditions or provision of certain information.

Partially approved – The matter has been partially approved, for example authorising less extensive trading hours or licensed area than what the applicant sought.

Refused – The matter has been rejected.

Under consideration – The matter is yet to be determined. A decision will be published once finalised.

Determined – The matter has been considered and determined, with decisions to be published where applicable.

Not considered – The matter was not considered at this meeting.

Withdrawn – The matter has been withdrawn.

Invalid – The matter has been deemed invalid.
